GAS KILN RENTAL REQUIREMENTS - 2019

Cone Packs:

You are required to make your own cone packs.

We can supply the cones if they are available. We charge \$1.00 per cone.

Adamah does not guarantee to have all cones in stock and available.

• <u>Cleaning</u>: VERY IMPORTANT!

Kiln shelves maintenance is the responsibility of the kiln renter: scraping and kiln washing the shelves. Make sure kiln wash is only applied to one side of the shelf and is washed off from the sides of the shelves.

Sweep the floor and replace the kiln furniture neatly for the next renter.

PLEASE **do not** remove the bottom layer of shelves or the first layer of brick spacers. Do not remove the front or rear target bricks. These have been accurately placed in the kiln to achieve the best firing results.



• Glazes:

Our cone 10 glazes are not "studio glazes": Adamah does not maintain or guarantee a stock set of glazes. Available glazes are remnants from our workshops and often there is no available test tile.

We offer the glazes for your use with your knowledge that you may need to mix them or add water if needed. For every pound of your bisque fired pot, we charge \$.50 to glaze.

We charge \$10 for every 1000g of dry glaze mix (unless there is a very expensive ingredient required). If you are interested in mixing a glaze at the studio, you need the director's permission.

• Kiln Firing Requirements:

Attendance at the kiln is required from start to finish.

You are not allowed to candle the gas kiln overnight.

If you are firing the kiln for a longer time than the typical 12 hour firing profile, you will be required to pay additional cost to pay for fuel: \$10/hour

The kiln is typically rented out for a series of 4 days: loading, firing, cooling, unloading

If you crack a shelf or cause damage to the kiln, it must be reported to the director.

Only use the shelves that are provided for the kiln. Do not use electric kiln shelves or the shelves from the wood kiln.

Each renter is asked to fill out a kiln log for their firing and leave it in the kiln log folder.

Prior knowledge of gas firing is required to rent the kiln.
